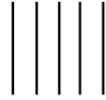

Laskarina Bouboulina Museum Tour

Guest Speaker: Paul Demertzis-Bouboulis, Bouboulina’s Great-grandson
Bouboulina Museum

A visit to Bouboulina’s Museum reveals the fascinating story of the heroine of the 1821 Greek Revolution for Independence, who until recently had the honor of being the only female Admiral in world Naval history. It also astounds with titbits of information, such as the links between Bouboulina, the Great Powers, the Tsar of Russia, blockade-running, and the 16-year-old Bavarian king of Greece, and of course not forgetting that Bouboulina is mentioned in a book by Jules Verne! During the tour of the mansion, visitors may admire collections of weapons, old books, porcelains, documents and letter, paintings and models of warships, the heroine’s personal items, embroidery, Byzantine icons, furniture, and the stunning carved ceiling from Florence in the grand salon of the mansion.

Laskarina Bouboulina

Bouboulina from the island of Spetses was a preeminent heroine of the 1821 Revolution for Independence: Owned a successful merchant fleet, built the largest Greek fighting ship, captured the fortress of Nafplion, saved hundreds of harem women, was the first woman admiral in the world, and served as an international diplomat. Extraordinary for a grandmother in the 1820s.

Manto Mavrogenous

Manto from the island of Mykonos was a fierce heroine of the 1821 Revolution for Independence: Skillful leader, won many battles, led military expeditions in Europe, spent her entire fortune for the revolution, and was an Honorary Lieutenant General. It was largely her fiery personality that convinced the Turks to retreat from Mykonos.

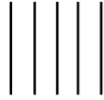
Despina Achladioti, Lady of Ro

The Lady of Ro, Despina Achladioti, was from the island of Kastellorizo. For 55 years (1927-1982), daily, she raised and lowered the Greek flag on the remote island of Ro, a stone's throw away from the Turkish coast. For her daily act of patriotism and her spirit of pride and determination Despina was buried on the island with full military honors.

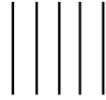
